

To the University of British Columbia:

A petition to build a bike path along the north side of Robert Lake

Access to the University of British Columbia's Okanagan campus by bicycle has been a long standing issue. Cycle commuters from the Rutland area have to cross a bridge on the highway that has no shoulder northbound, and those from the Mission/Downtown/Glenmore area have traditionally used Robert Lake Road, a private road with significant legal access issues extending over the past two decades. Despite these difficulties, there is a large and regular cycle commuter group.

The University of British Columbia is a strong supporter of sustainability and has devoted considerable effort into working with the city, the railroad industry, and the landowners on Robert Lake Road to develop a safe and legal route into campus for cycle commuters. Despite these efforts, there is no concrete plan in place that has a likely completion date within the next two years.

The acquisition of the endowment lands to the northwest of the campus provides us with a new opportunity to solve this problem. A potential route was scouted using a soft-terrain bicycle through the Endowment lands to the Mountain Weather Office on campus, and mapped using a GPS device (see attached image). This route is less than two kilometers long, has a maximum grade of less than seven percent, and is mostly flat. While at the moment the surface is primarily a grassy field, a bike path that could be ridden by novice cyclists could easily be created using a crushed gravel surface.

Advantages to the University and the University community:

1. A solution to the ongoing legal issues with the Robert Lake land owners, saving both time and legal expense.
2. A route to campus that is not intimidating to a new or novice cycle commuter, increasing the number of people willing to consider alternative transportation.
3. Reduced usage of automobile-specific infrastructure, such as parking and vehicle access.
4. A concrete milestone in achieving the University's mandate of reducing its ecological footprint.
